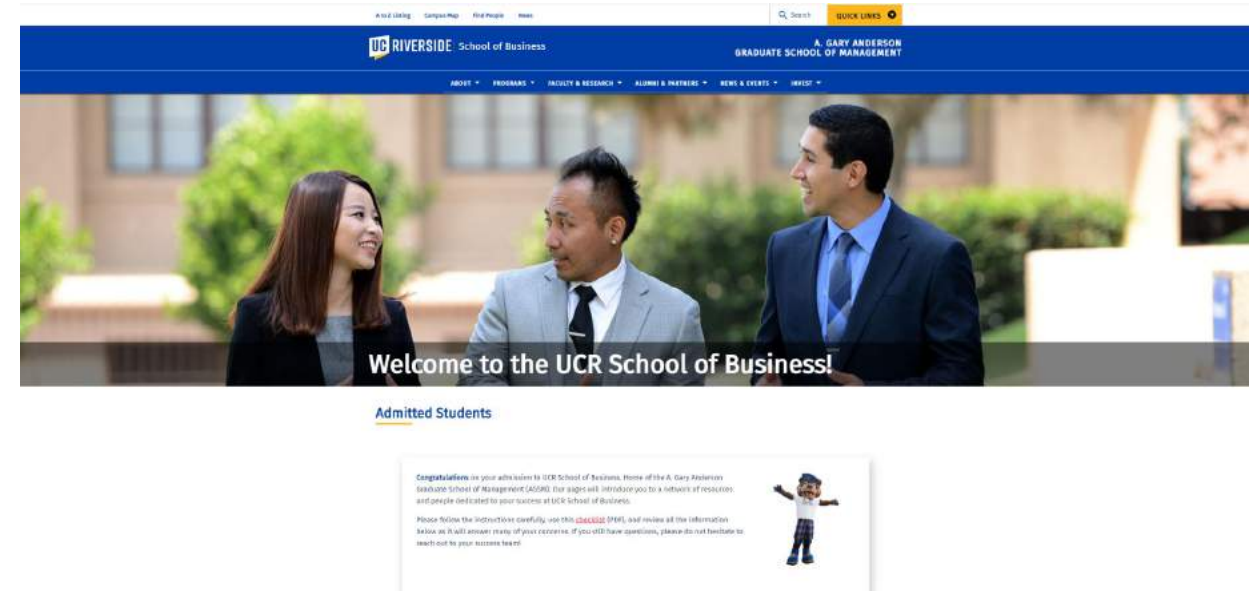

R'Web is Your Online Lifeline at UCR

- **R'Mail:** UCR Email - you will receive all your important information here!
 - Occasionally check your spam/junk inbox as well
- **Canvas:** Get updates from your classes, submit homework, find readings, check grades
- **Student Account:** Pay tuition and fees
- **DegreeWorks:** Check your degree progress
- **Student Profile:** See schedule and unofficial transcript
- **Holds:** Can review various holds that can prevent registration
- **Registration:** Sign up for classes and view course schedule

- MBA - fixed tuition cost (see link below)
- * The cost per quarter will be updated on the SBS link below closer to the Fall Quarter for 23-24 Academic Year.
- There are 2 fee deadlines per quarter, but you should always plan to pay by the first (initial) deadline. The second deadline is the “late” payment deadline.
- If you miss the fee payment deadlines, you will receive late fees and financial penalties.
- **Last Payment Deadline** for Fall 2023 is **September 28th at 4PM PST**.

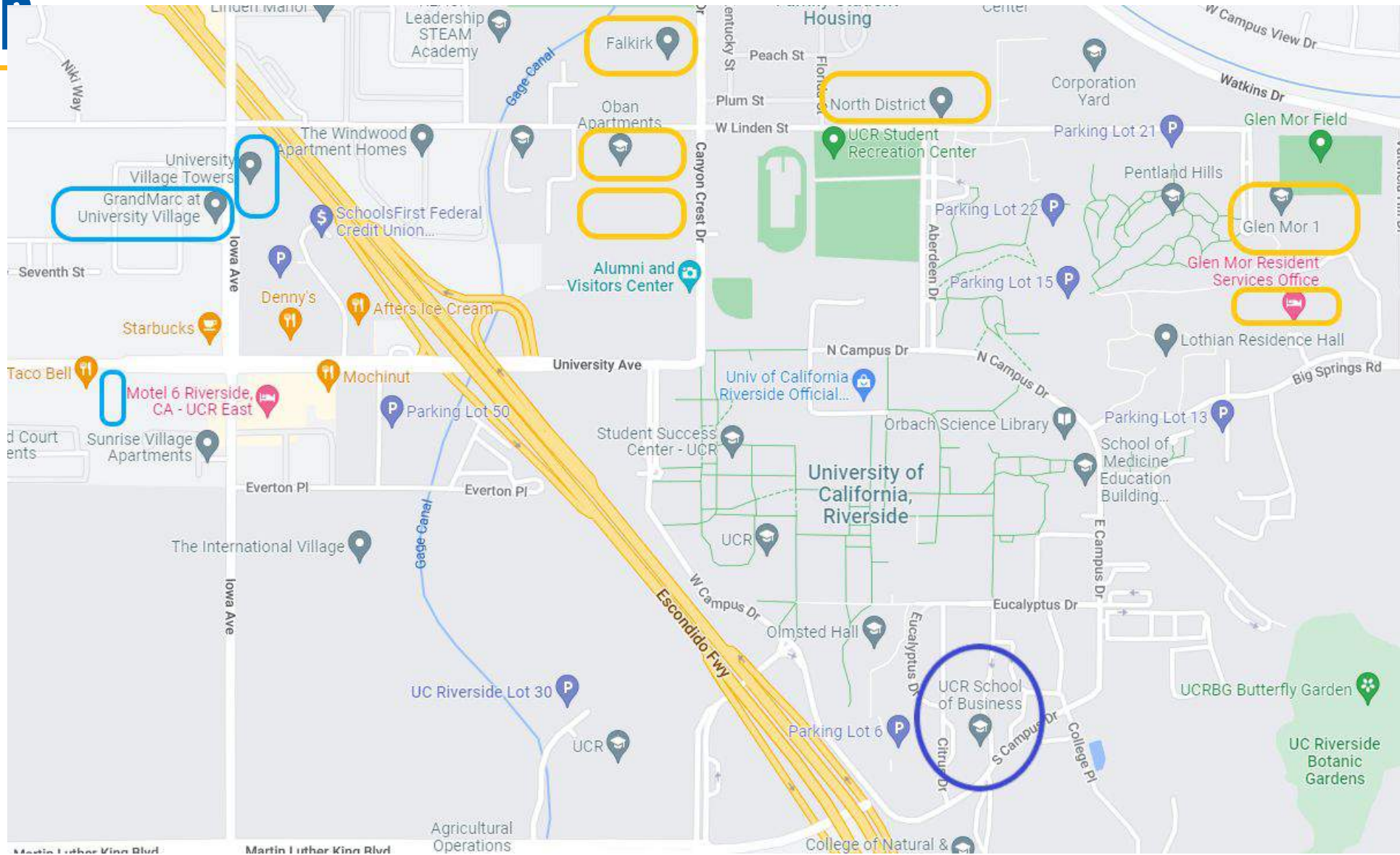
