

Master of Business Administration

The full-time MBA and Professional MBA programs are designed to unlock potential through exceptional educational experiences and foster success through an innovative. collaborative, and supportive environment.. The full-time MBA program is typically completed over the course of 21 months or two academic years. The Professional MBA is a highly flexible way to earn an MBA with course offerings on weekdays, evenings, or on the weekend. It mirrors the fulltime MBA coursework and can be completed in as little as 21 months or taken over several years as you drive your career forward. Choose among six (6) MBA concentrations: Accounting, Business Analytics, Finance, Management, Marketing, and Operations and Supply Chain Management.

Build a career in the world of finance as a Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA), Certified Financial Planner (CFP), or a member of the Global Association of Risk Professionals (GARP). This program educates client-facing professionals in understanding, translating, and presenting complex financial instruments to their clients, and offers career pathways in investments and corporate finance. The MFin curriculum prepares you with the knowledge and skills to utilize derivatives, inform investment decisions, and manage portfolios.

Master of Professional Accountancy

Practicum Track with Concurrent CPT Available.

Establish a career in accounting with career pathways to advanced education in auditing, financial reporting, taxation, and in cost and managerial accounting. The program offers entrance to students from non-accounting backgrounds through our admissions Track II. while students from accounting backgrounds can finish more quickly via Track I. UCR's MPAc program provides an excellent opportunity for students to study advanced topics in accounting, auditing, and taxation while earning additional units that help them qualify for the CPA license. Students will also gain important professional research and communication skills that are sure to help them succeed in their careers. Begin your program in either the fall or winter quarter.
