LEADERSHIP WORKSHOP

This leadership workshop is an introduction to the MBA program that provides students core knowledge in management, including the planning, organizing, and problem solving of organizational resources in order to achieve organizational goals. The workshop is designed around the assessment and development of four managerial skills: communication, leadership, teamwork, and ethical decision making. We approach these skills from three perspectives: a focus on the leader, the team and the system.

Through topics and assignments, we aim to achieve the following:

- Develop an awareness of the knowledge, skills, and attributes necessary to effective leadership.
- Identify key interpersonal and team skills to high performing teams.
- Learn how to provide and receive behavioral feedback.
- Develop personal action plans for short- and longterm managerial development

CAREER DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP

Our career-focused workshop develops critical career management skills through greater understanding of abilities, preferences, and job search resources. Lessons will boost students' proficiency in career-enhancing techniques such as resume building, networking, interviewing, & salary negotiation. Instructors provide hands-on learning in collaboration with industry professionals.

Upon completion the students will:

- Learn how to manage the development of their own careers.
